Snapshot Survey Now Open: COVID-19 and the Coaching Industry

Just weeks after we closed the 2019 Global Coaching Survey in December 2019, the outbreak of COVID-19 began to impact members of the coaching community in Asia. It has since had a dramatic impact on the way coaches and clients live, work and connect with one another around the world.

COVID-19 and the Coaching Industry is a global survey open to professional coach practitioners and to managers and leaders who use coaching skills in their roles. The purpose of this research is to collect up-to-date information on the state of the coaching industry, enabling a side-by-side comparison of two snapshots: the coaching industry, pre- and mid-pandemic.

The survey is available in English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin, Portuguese and Spanish.
